Monday, May 1st

(Percussion Ensembles and Concert Band 1)

- 5:30 pm Percussionists meet to set up equipment
- 6:00 pm Percussion sound check on stage
- 6:30 pm Concert 1 in band room for warm up
- 7:00 pm Concert begins with percussion ensemble performances, followed by Concert Band 1
- 8:00 pm Concert ends, percussionists move equipment back to band room

Tuesday, May 2nd

(Symphonic 2, Symphonic 1, and Wind Ensemble)

- 6:15 pm Symphonic 2 on stage for warm up
- 6:45 pm Symphonic 1 in orchestra room for warm up
- 7:00 pm Wind Ensemble in band room for warm up
- 7:00 pm Concert begins

Concert Dress for Band Members

Boys are required to wear dress slacks, collared shirt with a tie, dress socks and dress shoes (suit coats and sport coats are optional). Girls will wear dresses, skirts, or nice pants with dress shoes. No shorts, jeans, tennis shoes, etc. Proper attire is part of the performance grade.

Concert Dress for Percussion Ensemble Musicians

Percussion Ensemble members will wear concert black, which includes black slacks for men, black slacks or knee length skirts/dresses for women, black button shirt or blouse, and black shoes and black socks.

There is no cost for the concert but those attending are encouraged to stay for the whole program. We are recognizing our superintendent for purchasing our uniforms and we want everyone to be there to show our support.

Make sure you arrive early enough to find a parking spot so you are not late for your warm up or performance (especially Wind Ensemble students).
