KEY POINTS - Overall

- We are leaving on Wednesday, December 27th. Be here between 2:00 p.m. and 2:30 p.m. unless you are loading the trucks, then be here at 2:00 p.m.
- We are driving straight through with bus drivers changing every 8 hours.

- For parents that are traveling separately (not chaperoning), be in place for parades at both parks at least one (1) hour before the parade is set to begin. Parade routes fill up quickly and you want to get a great spot for pictures and video.
- Any pictures or video you take, please send a copy to Mr. Harper.
- At the Disney Parade, we will be given an orientation, there will be changing stations, and NO pictures are allowed backstage. We will be treated as a Disney employee during the parade. Uniforms will be on the buses.
- Universal Studios will handle their parade in a similar fashion. The parade crew in FL has been waiting for some of the balloons and floats that were used in the Thanksgiving Day Parade to arrive in FL for the Christmas Parade.
- Right after the Universal Parade, head to the Castle for their spectacular light show.
- On December 31st, Disney does fireworks in each country prior to the big event at Midnight.
- Tickets will be given out next week. You can go online and get your Disney Fast Pass once you get your ticket. DO NOT FORGET TO BRING THIS WITH YOU!
- Check your hotel rooms thoroughly before leaving! Do not leave anything behind!
- We will return to Fayetteville at 1:30 a.m. on Tuesday, January 2nd. We need to unload everything prior to leaving the High School. Please be sure someone is there to pick up your student.

KEY POINTS FROM THE PACKET

Big Cities & Guidelines— Extremely important to remember. Big Cities are not like small towns. All Band Members must be with other band members. NO ONE SHOULD EVER BE ALONE.

What to Pack – Point #2 & #7 are Key (see in packet below). **Point #2 will be part of your semester final grade!** Be sure to bring a Portable Charger for your phone.

Motor Coach Rules – With bathroom etiquette - #1 is o.k., #2 is not. We will stop enough for you to use other restroom facilities.

Guidelines & Rules for a Smooth Trip – Read this carefully! Anything you can get suspended for at school, you can get suspended for one this trip. If sent home, it will be at the parent's expense and you will be able to pick up your student with Mr. Jacoby.

- Over 200 are going on this trip. **Remember, you are representing Fayetteville High School at ALL times.** Please remember to keep behavior and crankiness in check.
- On the Room lists, the first person on the list is Room Captain. When you arrive in your room, check lights, toilets, phones, TV, etc. If anything is broken, report it to your chaperone immediately. If anything is broken when leaving, you will be responsible.

If you were unable to attend, please fill out the pages at the end and turn into Band ASAP.

As an approved trip of Fayetteville High School, all rules and policies set forth in the student handbook will be in effect for the duration of this trip.

GROUP TRAVEL HINTS:

1. Good manners are always a plus wherever you are.
2. Cooperate with your chaperones and keep them notified where your group is going to be at all times.
3. If you feel ill, tell your chaperone immediately!
4. Review your itinerary and be aware of your responsibilities.
5. Moving a large group takes longer than moving an individual. Keep a smile, be patient, listen, and cooperate. Be considerate and arrive on time. Being late holds up the entire group.
6. Eat properly. Don't load up on junk food, and eat a balanced meal.
7. Get plenty of sleep at night. You will enjoy the trip more when properly rested.
8. Don't spread rumors; if you have any questions, ask your chaperone or director.

HOTEL INSTRUCTIONS

CHECK IN PROCEDURE:

** 30 minutes prior to arrival at hotel, students should begin cleaning their area and putting their belongings together.**

1. **Male chaperones and directors will exit buses first.** Retrieve luggage and enter hotel lobby. Male chaperones will proceed to their assigned floors to assist students with room location and maintain a quiet atmosphere.
2. **Room captains will receive room keys on their bus, then exit buses shortly thereafter.** Retrieve luggage and enter the hotel lobby to give out room keys. All room keys will be given to the room captain.
3. **All other students will exit the buses, retrieve luggage, enter the hotel lobby, and find their room captain to receive their room keys.** There will be personnel assigned to assist you in locating your room.
4. **Female chaperones will check buses for cleanliness.** Also check for purses, wallets, etc. that will have been accidentally left behind. Retrieve luggage and obtain room key in the hotel lobby.
5. Any room problems should be reported immediately to a chaperone by the room captain.
6. Read the instructions provided in your room concerning escape in case of an emergency.
7. At curfew, you must be in your own room. No one is to enter your room after this time except chaperones or staff.
8. Keep the noise level down. It is important that chaperones and travel directors are not called by hotel management because of unnecessary noise from your room.
9. Elevators are used to transport all hotel guests. When using them, respect the fact that there are other guests staying at the hotel. No horsing around or jumping up and down in the elevators.
10. Do not remove towels or other “souvenirs” from your room. You will have to pay for them.
11. Do not drop or throw ANYTHING from hotel windows.
12. Keep your room locked at all times! Know who has the key. Safeguard your personal belongings. The hotel safe is available to lock up valuables.
13. No girls in boys’ room or boys in girls’ rooms – NO EXCEPTIONS!
14. All clothing and other loose items must be stored in your luggage and/or hotel drawers and closets before we leave the hotel everyday.
15. Pay-Per-View movies in the room will be turned off.
16. Chaperones will check your rooms at curfew for cleanliness and to go over any announcements.

Travel Tips

The following items are general information about the trip you are taking. These items provide an idea for your students, chaperones and fans about what to expect from the trip and how to prepare for it.

WEATHER AND CLIMATE

The average temperature in Orlando for this time of year is in the mid-70's for highs and the upper 50's for lows. For up to date weather information prior to your departure, we suggest you watch "The Weather Channel" or visit www.weather.com.

BIG CITIES and GUIDELINES

For those of you unfamiliar with a big city, walking around will be different than strolling around your hometown. Big city streets are very crowded with people rushing along at a fast pace. This calls for you to be very alert and aware of your surroundings.

1. Keep within your group. Make sure that you are NEVER totally alone. Always be with at least one other person from your group.
2. Because of possible security checks, students should be prepared to have bags, purses, etc. checked at any time.
3. Keep a firm grip on your personal belongings and keep your wallet in your front pocket.
4. Pay attention to traffic signals and don't walk too close to the curb.
5. Be extremely cautious about striking up conversation with strangers. If you are repeatedly bothered by someone, tell your chaperone or director.
6. Please remember-drugs, alcohol, or tobacco are never allowed to be used by anyone on this trip.
7. Shoplifting is a serious offense. Anyone caught will be turned over to the local police.
8. **BE ON TIME!** We are on a structured schedule. Make sure that you listen and follow instructions so that you can make all departures on time.
9. **Students who break the rules will be sent home at their parent's expense.**

WHAT TO PACK

1. One suitcase will be stored under the bus. One small carry-on bag may be brought on the bus and must be able to fit under the seat or in the rack above your seats. Remember that items stored in your suitcase under the bus will not be accessible; they are under the bus in storage. If there is something that you anticipate you may need before we arrive, you should place it in your carry-on bag. Make sure that you have your name and address on your instrument and on all of your luggage.
2. Uniforms (including black band shoes, black socks, black compression shirt, and black shorts) will be checked in prior to our departure. Be sure that these items are clean and ready to pack. These will be loaded on the equipment truck.
3. Please bring a picture ID with you. This can be a driver's license or student ID.
4. Toiletries and medication. Do not pack medication in your suitcase. Keep it with you at all times. Take along a written prescription in case you lose your medication and need to have it refilled. All medications must be checked with a chaperone.
5. Alarm clock, hair dryer, etc. Check with our roommates; each person doesn't need to pack the same appliances. Use the "buddy system."
6. Take anything you feel you may need (as long as it fits in your suitcase). Almost everything is more expensive away from home.
7. Instrument and accessories (reeds, valve oil, etc.).

8. Pack all liquid items (lotion, shampoo, etc.) in plastic bags so that they do not damage clothing if they spill.
9. Bring an umbrella or poncho and check the weather 1-2 days before the trip to make sure you are bringing weather appropriate clothing. Rain is likely at some point during our trip.
10. Leave space in your luggage for souvenirs and gifts you may purchase to take home.

EQUIPMENT

1. Each person is solely responsible for his/her own equipment, luggage, etc. Do not assume that someone else will take care of it for you. Make sure that all possessions are properly loaded and unloaded.
2. All percussionists and people playing large instruments will be present for loading and unloading of their equipment.
3. When we arrive back in Fayetteville, everyone is responsible for his/her own equipment.

MOTORCOACH INSTRUCTIONS

1. Blankets and pillows are allowed on the coach. Music listening devices may be used but please, as a courtesy to others – especially the driver – headphones must be used. Personal items are your own responsibility.
2. Do not leave personal items on the coach overnight.
3. Food may be taken on board as long as the coach is kept clean and neat. Any spillage should be taken care of immediately. Milk products and glass are prohibited.
4. Please treat your driver with respect and courtesy.
5. A rest room is provided for your convenience. It is equipped with a chemical toilet and once it is full, it is unusable until it can be emptied. Do not use it unnecessarily and do not flush any foreign objects down it. Try to use the restroom at rest stops whenever possible. Also, smoking is not allowed in the motor coach rest room.
6. Do not disembark until your Travel Director or Director releases you. (Your stop may not last very long!)
7. Please NO flash photography on board the coach.

MONEY NEEDED

Take enough money for snacks, souvenirs and all meals not listed in your tour conditions. **We are planning to provide all meals for the duration of the trip.** Take travelers checks, not cash, if you plan to carry much money. Keep a list of serial numbers in a separate place in the event they are lost or stolen. **If a person does not plan to purchase souvenirs, I would recommend \$75.00 in extra cash.** If a person does plan to buy souvenirs, I would add to that amount (depending on how many people you are buying for). Snacks and souvenirs at Walt Disney World and Universal Orlando are very expensive.

WHAT TO WEAR

Casual wear is appropriate for the entire trip.

Please, no ripped/torn jeans on this trip! You are representing your school and hometown. Be sure to wear comfortable shoes, as we will be walking a great deal. Hats and sunscreen are also highly recommended during the day.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF CHAPERONES

The main responsibility of the chaperones is to help students have a safe and enjoyable trip. They are on the trip to help students make wise choices. The chaperones are not there to make sure that students behave. This is the responsibility of the individual student. The chaperone is just there to help students have a safe trip and assist the directors when necessary.
