

FHS Band Booster Spring Trip Meeting Minutes

April 11, 2013

The bus company, Time Line, that we have used in the past is no longer available, and we are going with a new company – Caballa.
- Mr. Harper introduced the chaperones, and handed out a trip packet to all students going on the trip. The remainder of the time was spent in having the students check in with their assigned chaperone.
