Kim Hadley presented a budget summary, including an update of the JM Scholarship

- Information included a breakdown of expenses (e.g. trips, uniform maintenance)
- Kim noted that the share of funds are derived from fundraising activities undertaken by the band and not student fees

Barry Harper took floor to continue meeting

- He began with a highlight of the 2014 season (e.g. concerts, competitions)
- Presentation continued with a description of the 2014 - 2015 band
 - Reminder that students need to be present for practices
 - Guard camp, summer camp dates announced
 - There are 198 kids signed up to date
 - Trips discussed
 - Trip account, by June 6 have \$200
 - Fundraising options discussed, including walk a thon
 - New contest, Ozark, in the fall (9/26/2014)
 - Band website discusses program format
 - Alternate / reserve definition
 - Competitive and halftime participation based on skill level, attitude, gpa, periodically reviewed
 - Director will be working with alternates to improve skills (new)
 - Everyone marches at Disney, all travel to all trips
